Greetings to Hunter Valley Scots Club Members and friends,

One of the primary reasons for this newsletter is for you to consider two matters of real importance – we need your thoughts regarding these matters.

1. What does the future hold for Hunter Valley Scots Club?

As a Club it has successfully promoted Scottish culture in the area both directly through HVSC activities or in association with other Scottish or Multicultural groups in the area for at least 40 years. Unfortunately, member numbers are decreasing and the average age of members is increasing. All the executive positions on the Management Committee will be vacant at the AGM in September. Will we have a Club after the AGM?

2. Since 1989 the Club has held a lease on Teralba Hall allowing for a place for the Club to call home, use for meetings and other activities, and to store equipment etc. Lake Macquarie City Council also allows the Club to sublease the hall to other community groups such as exercise classes, yoga, dance classes, folk groups, and other social activities – the administration of the subleasing of the hall is provided by HVSC as a community service. The lease runs until February 2024. **Do we continue with this lease and the workload or decide that it is not in the best interest of the HVSC?**

Caledonian Night

One of the many successful events over latter years has been the Caledonian Night and 15 July 2023 was no exception. A good crowd of people enjoyed the evening including quite a number of younger people – those involved with the Highland Dancing and others along with their families.

We always appreciate the generosity of Club Macquarie for allowing us to have the room free of charge, and it has been agreed that for the benefit of our members and their staff the supper will be at 8.45pm next time with perhaps a return to supper provided on platters or similar rather than individual plates.
